The Barren River Rod and Gun Club Campground Protocol (Effective Sept. 1, 2025)

- 1. Club members must call or inform a board member of their intent to use campgrounds via phone, text, email, or in person. Please disclose the estimated number in your party and length of stay. (The notified board member will then inform the rest of the board of campground use.)
- 2. There must be at least one camping club member present on grounds per 10 camping guests. (The use of ranges while camping is still limited to 2 guests per 1 membership, at a time.)
- 3. Length of stay can be up to 21 consecutive days (3 weeks). Any stay beyond 3 weeks must have board approval. Any and all use of campgrounds is at the Board's discretion.
- 4. The campgrounds are available to multiple campers at one time. The Club only permits and allows use of the campgrounds and does not "reserve" sites or hold dates.
- 5. Dogs and other pets are allowed. Pets must be on leash or tethered and never unattended. There is noise from firing guns as well as abundant wildlife, and we do not want your pet to run off. Your pet(s) must be under your control at all times. Please pick up after your pet.
- 6. The Club provides firewood at the campground and there is no need to bring your own. To help prevent spreading disease from outside sources, please do NOT bring your own firewood.
- 8. Do not leave campfires unattended. Campfires must be completely extinguished upon departure.
- 7. Alcohol is NOT permitted on the property, including the campgrounds.
- 8. Please make every effort to clean up your campsite upon leaving and report anything that may need our attention to a board member, so that we can address it and improve the campground for future use.
